

Internship Program

WBC Counseling offers internships for the final year of master's-level counseling students. All internships are unpaid for students gaining counseling hours for college credit and/or graduation.

Requirements

- Minimum ten (10) sessions per week
- In-person and virtual sessions
- Carry student liability insurance

Benefits

- Weekly supervision
- Supportive staff
- HIPPA-compliant email
- Ongoing training
- Exposure to various clients age, gender, economic background, ethnicity, etc.
- Opportunity to learn and work with concerns such as depression, anxiety, oppositional defiant, TBI, social conflicts, trauma, etc.

Application Process

- Submission of a resume, cover letter, and academic transcripts
- Interview with internship supervisors

Duration and Schedule

- Commit to at least 2 semesters with WBC Counseling
- Flexible hours days, evenings, and/or weekends

Internship Responsibilities

- Maintain accurate and confidential client records
- Engage in professional development activities, such as attending training and workshops
- Attending staff meetings

Supervision and Support

• Interns will be assigned a licensed supervisor who will provide guidance, feedback, and oversight throughout the internship

• Interns will have access to resources and support staff to assist with any challenges that may arise during their internship.

Evaluation and Feedback

- Interns will receive regular performance evaluations from their supervisor based on observation, client feedback, and completion of assigned tasks.
- Feedback will be provided to help interns identify strengths and areas for growth, including opportunities for goal setting and skill development.
- Interns will receive client satisfaction surveys upon completing the internship program.
- Interns will complete an exit interview upon completing the internship program.

Code of Conduct and Ethics:

 Interns are expected to adhere to the company's code of conduct, including maintaining professionalism, confidentiality, and ethical standards in all interactions with clients and staff.

Conclusion of Internship:

- Upon completion of the internship, interns may receive a certificate of completion and/or a letter of recommendation from their supervisor.
